Passengers wishing to board the train at Kelling Heath must give a clear signal to the Driver. Passengers wishing to alight there must advise the Guard when boarding the train. It is not possible to board or alight from a train at Kelling Heath unless it is booked as a request stop.

CONNECTION POLICY
Sheringham: Some connections possible - Weybourne: Connections usually possible - Holt: Connections not possible due to the distance between platforms

The NNR appreciates that some passengers like to make short connections between arriving and departing trains. Where possible we will accommodate passengers trying to make these connections if they make their way to the departing train promptly and safely. However it will not usually be possible to hold trains beyond their booked departure times due to the intensity of the service, particularly in the event of late running. Boarding or alighting of trains after the 'right away' is given or before the train has stopped is not permitted. Please note that the Guard has the final decision on when to depart and whether passengers may travel.

Trains with Multiple Locos
Unless absolutely necessary, locos on the rear of trains and locos acting as a brake translator should not apply traction power. This is to allow the front loco(s) to haul heavier trains.

Tickets

Facilities

There are buffets and souvenir shops at the three main stations. Sheringham buffet will be serving hot food until 14:00.

There is also a real ale bar in the ladies' waiting room on platform 1 at Sheringham.

The 'Muddle & Go Nowhere' Gresley bar car is on Set A, serving real ale, hot and cold drinks and snacks.

The Restaurant Buffet car is on Set B, offering all day breakfasts, hot and cold drinks, snacks and bottled ales from the licensed bar.
